

Burial of optical fiber cable ducts



Overview

The short answer, based on general industry standards and the National Electrical Code (NEC), is that fiber optic cable is typically buried between 24 inches (60 cm) and 30 inches (76 cm) deep. However, simply hitting this depth isn't enough to guarantee your network survives. For project owners and OSP designers, the key decision is not only whether to bury fiber, but how to choose the right installation method and cable structure for each section of the route: direct burial, duct, trough or micro-duct air-blown systems. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. This cable is built to specific tolerances to heat, moisture, conductivity, and soil acidity. Burying these cables protects them from physical damage, weather, and unauthorized access, but the depth varies based on location, cable type, and local.
