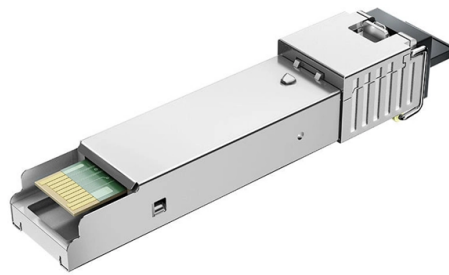


Cable near distribution box margin



Overview

Where cables enter a distribution board from trunking, the cables must be protected from any sharp edges in order to comply with 522. Common methods of complying include deburring edges and using grommet strips or manufactured spacers. In industrial power distribution systems, cable distribution boxes (also known as power distributor boxes, distribution electrical boxes, or electrical power distribution boxes) are the core hub of power transmission, branching, and protection. A cable with return-loss margin above the standard reduces the amount of work the physical layer (PHY) inside your equipment must put forth to keep.
