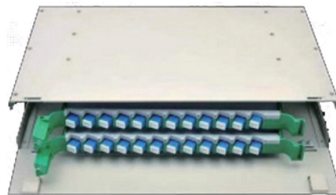


Fiber optic splicing and joint loss rate



Overview

For each connector, we usually figure 0.3 dB loss for most adhesive/polish or fusion splice-on connectors. 75 max per EIA/TIA 568) Mechanical splicing means that two fiber ends are tightly held together with some mechanical means. That is usually done for permanent connections, but it may be possible to dismantle a splice without spoiling the fiber ends. Another technique is fusion splicing, where the fibers are fused. Typical splice loss values (the measure of loss in optical power across the splice point) are usually lower for fusion splices (typically less than 0. To be able to judge whether a fiber optic cable plant is good, one does a insertion loss test with a light source and power meter and compares that to an estimate of what is a reasonable loss for that cable plant.
