Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded.
