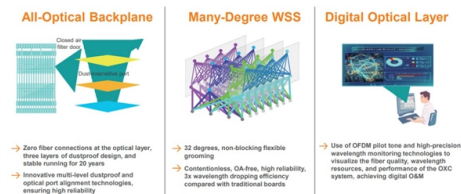


Network Engineering Optical Cable

Fiber-optic cabling is widely used for high-speed Ethernet links over relatively long distances. It uses glass or plastic fiber as a medium through which light is "guided" to the other end of the link. These systems are critical to ensuring robust and high-speed communication networks. A fiber-optic cable, also known as an optical-fiber cable, is an assembly similar to an electrical cable but containing one or more optical fibers that are used to carry light.
