Overview

Your breaker box wiring includes three main wire types: black hot wires carry electricity to outlets, white neutral wires return unused power, and green ground wires prevent electrocution. According to NEC Article 250, both the neutral and ground wires must be connected only in the main panel or at the first service disconnect. This practice is essential. If the Neutral Conductor is opened, broke or lost at either of its source side (distribution transformer, generator) or at load side (distribution panel of a consumer), the distribution system's neutral conductor will “float” or lose its reference ground Point. It is the critical interface where the utility's power is divided into individual branch circuits that feed the lights, outlets, and appliances. This fact sheet explains how to apply the requirements shown in AS/NZS 3012:2019 Electrical installations – construction and demolition sites (AS/NZS 3012:2019), which is called up as a mandatory standard by section 163 of the Work Health and Safety Regulation 2025 (WHS Regulation).
