

Requirements for cable binding wires inside cable trays



Overview

Article 392 of the NEC provides the basic requirements for installations using cable tray. The respective article for the cable type must also be followed. 60(A) "Metal Area Requirements for Cable Trays used as Equipment Grounding Conductors" shows the minimum cross-sectional area of cable tray side rails (total of both side rails) required for the cable tray to be used as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) for a specific Fuse Rating. Cable trays play a vital role in supporting electrical cables and wires in commercial, industrial, and utility installations. The flexibility and scalability of cable trays make them an ideal choice for environments where cable density and organization can. The primary rulebook used in the safe use of cable trays is NEC Article 392. You should consider it as a series of instructions that make the buildings resistant to. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. When designing a cable tray wiring system, the designer should evaluate the National Electrical Code's (NEC) Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) options that are applicable for the project. [The cable tray may only be used as an EGC in qualifying facilities as stated.
