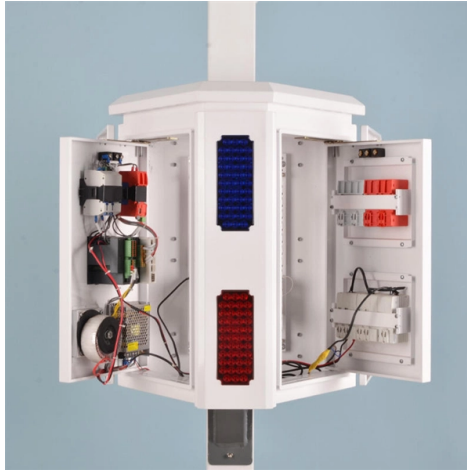
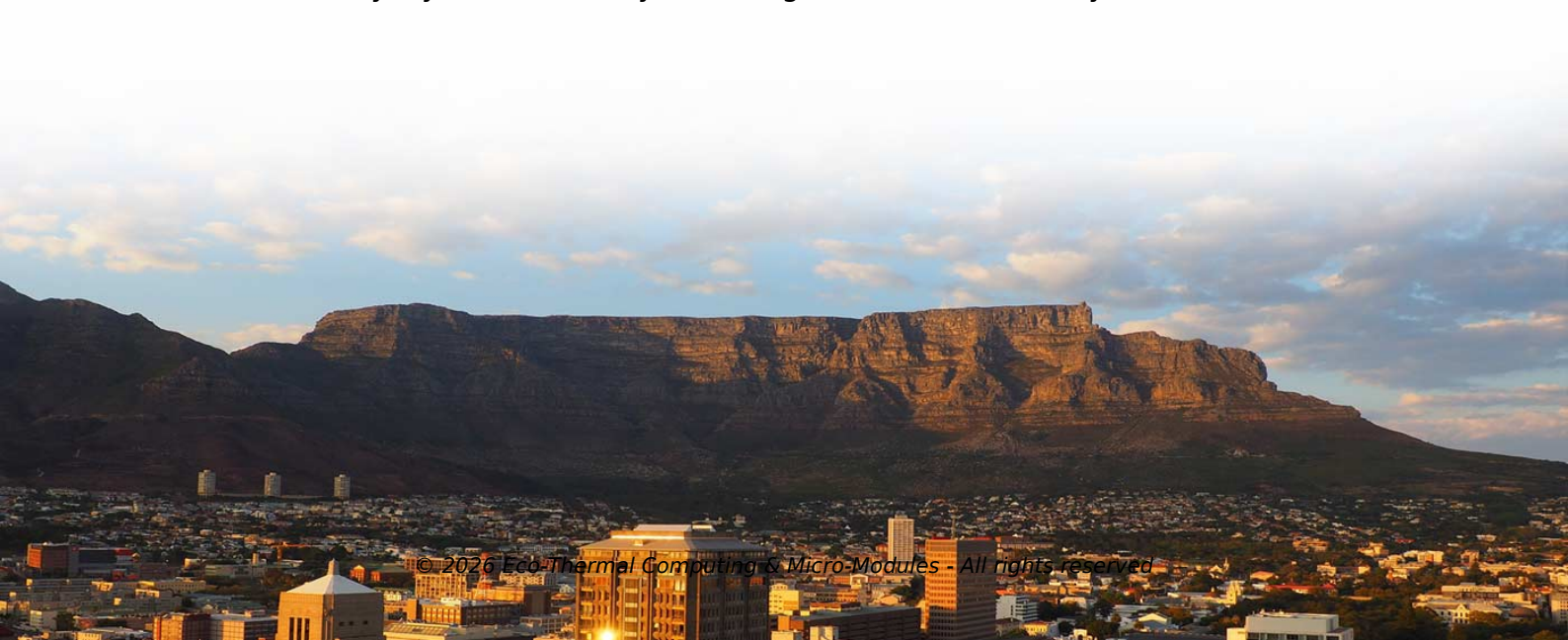


Spacing between fire cable trays and power cable trays
