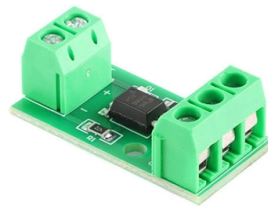
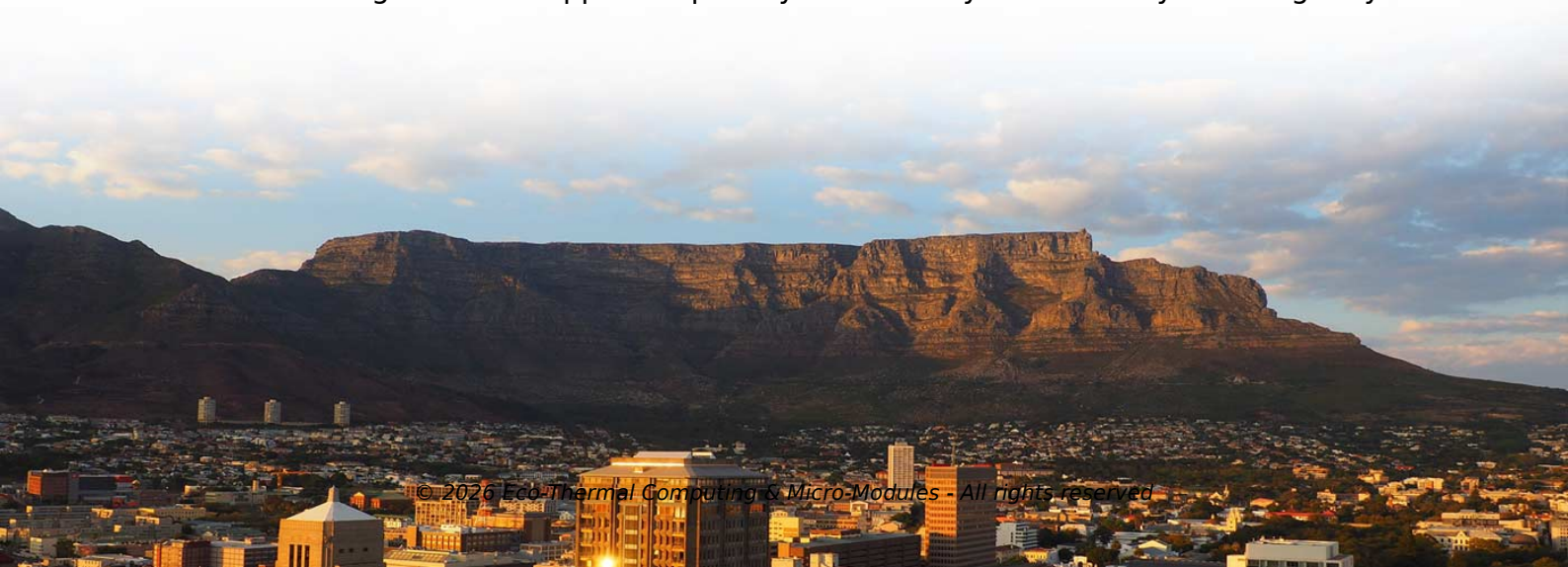


Standard Table for Grounding Dimensions of Distribution Boxes



Overview

The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides clear guidelines for ground wire sizing through Table 250. 122, but understanding how to apply these requirements correctly can make the difference between a safe installation and a costly code violation. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. The rule links the minimum size of the grounding conductor directly to the rating of the overcurrent protective device protecting the circuit, such as a circuit breaker or fuse.
